Blacker, Edward, of Wilts, arm. QUEEN'S COLL., matric. 16 June, 1610, aged 15; B.A. 1 March 1613-14, probably brother of Thomas and William.

Blacker, Edward, 2s. William, of Salisbury, Wilts, arm. CHRIST CHURCH, matric. 26 June, 1635, aged 18; a student of Lincoln's Inn 1634. See Foster's *Inns of Court Reg.*

Blacker, Thomas, of Wilts, arm., fil. nat. 2. QUEEN'S COLL., matric. 7 Dec., 1621, aged 16; B.A. 7 July, 1625; 2nd son of William, and aged 20, at the Heralds' Visitation in 1613.

Blacker, William, of Wilts, gent. CHRIST CHURCH, matric. 13 Dec., 1605, aged 17; bar.-at-law, Lincoln's Inn, 1613, as son of William, esq., father of Edward 1635, and brother of Thomas last named, and probably of Edward 1610. See Foster's *Judges and Barristers*.
