TREASONABLE WORDS.

Examination held before Robt. Willoughby, lord Broke, Wm. Carrant, esq., and George Twynyoo, justices of the peace, and the mayor of Shayftisbury, at Warder, 13 Feb. 12 Hen. VIII.

Alen Turell, Rauf Turell, John Bowiar, Wm. Tailor and Peter Swasshe (?), of Shayftisbury, say they were in the house of Thos. Blacker, of Shayftisbury, on Candelmas Day³, and heard John Brode, of Shayftisbury, call John Williams, of Shayftisbury, "a vacabunde" and thief; when Williams said he was no vacabund, as he had served King Henry in his wars. Then Brode said, "A, sir, have ye ben with Maistre Henry Kyng? A noble act ye did ther! Ye spent away my money and other mennys, like a sort of

vacbaunds and knaves!” And so they departed, and would no longer tarry in his company.
