Bedingfield Kt Attorney of the Dutcht and M^r Clearke of Lincolnes Inne It is therefore ordered that the said def' shall aunswear the bill by this day seavenight and haue the Councill desired assigned him in forma pauperis

Vpon openinge of the matter this p'nte day vnto this Court by M^r Reeves being of the pl't^s Councell and vpon readeinge of an order of the xxijth of Aprill last it was alleadged that by an order of the xiiijth of February last A habeas Corpus was Awarded to bringe the Def't Blacker to the barr to shewe Cause whie he should not Answer the pl't^s bill of whie in default thereof the bill should not be taken p^r confesso and the Defendant beinge brought into Court by virtue of the said writt did not refuze to Answer but in regard of his povertie prayed to haue Councell assigned to drawe his Answer wch was done accordingelie and by the said order of the 22th of Aprill last that day senight was given to the Def't to answer the pl't^s bill howbeit the Def't hath not in all this Tyme putt in any Answer thervnto as by Certificate from the pl't^s Attorney now alsoe reade appeared It is therefore ordered that the Defendant be comitted Close prisoner to the Fleete there to remayne vntill the said Def' shall putt in A full and perfect Answer to the pl't^s bill according to the said former order
