1. Edward Alfrey (1621-1672) married Susan Blaker before 1655. Susan was born about 1619 and was buried on 8 April 1676 in Shoreham, Sussex. Susan was the daughter of Edward Blaker (c1570-1652) a gentleman of Portslade, Sussex and Susanna Scrase (?-1679).
