



EDITORIAL

Considerable discretion must be used in selecting the content of the Newsletter. We try to avoid printing anything that could be embarrassing to any of our readers. We do not divulge how much anyone living was left in a will. We do not point out hasty marriages nor the absence of a father at a baptism.

From time to time items may appear such as a Blaker being brought before the Justice but the event will be so remote in time that the culprit will have become more endearing for his crime.

We have been asked for assurance that the information supplied by our members will not be passed on to any organization, religious or commercial. This assurance is given. The information we have accumulated is solely for the benefit of our members. We have no intention of offering for sale wall plaques, crests with horse's heads, or even beer mugs. To enable members to trace their ancestors in the ease of their armchairs, rather than the discomfort of a record office, we shall, from time to time, offer for sale a publication that we have been able to produce from the information at our disposal. One such aid is now in production and we are able to take orders with delivery to be made early in July.

We have a list of all the deaths (approx. 1100) shown in the Index to Deaths at Alexandra House, London, (until 1980 at St. Catherine's House). These run from July, 1837, to Dec., 1980. We shall dispense with dividing the year into quarters for the sake of brevity and to save postage. However, the year's listing will be in sequence so that one near the beginning of a year's listing will indicate that it occurred early in the year.

From 1837, the year, name and place are shown. From 1866, the age at death is also shown. From mid-1968, the date of birth, as supplied by the informant, replaces the age.

The cost of this publication is £2 including postage. We request that you send two pound notes to facilitate banking.
