### WRO 520/1 Release & Quitclaim

New Sarum (Salisbury) 15 Nov 1527.

Release & quitclaim of a little tenement with appurtenances in St Martins (Church) Street, Salisbury, between the tenement of Simon Gilforde on the east, John Sperynge chaplain, on the west, and tenements St Edmunds on the north, which Thomas Batte lately had out of the gift of Thomas Geralde *alias* **Blacker**, of the city, tanner.

Parties: Thomas Batte, innkeeper, John Batte, his son, and Alice his wife.

### WRO 212B/7192 Appointment

1571 Nov 2.

(1) Freake, Edmund, Dean of Salisbury, and the Chapter.

(2) **Blacker**, William.

Appointment as Receiver for all the manors etc. in co's Wilts, Berks, Somerset, Dorset and Hampshire.

Common seal of the chapter, chipped.

- *Note: We have photos of WRO 212B/7189 through to WRO 212B/7218. One item, labelled Wilts General 7189-7218 seems to relate to peramulations around various forests. No mention of Bla(c)ker. Only WRO 212B/7192 relates to Blacker.*

### WRO 164/11/2 Court Rolls

1616-1681

Court Book of the manors of Edward & William **Blacker** of Pierston in Gillingham, Dorset and West Harnham. Volume rebound, original cover now loose.

*Note: we only seem to have a photo of the cover of the court book.*
