 shall be bequeathed and not given I give and bequeath  
 unto my loving wife Alice Blaker my house and  
 all other things to be my wifes executrixs And my last  
 will and Testament my buriall performed and charged  
 payd And my mynde is that my sayd wifes shall  
 have and enjoy the use of all such good stuffe as is  
 bequeathed and given and bequeathed during her naturall life  
 And I doo devise make and appoint Edward Connor  
 and Thomas Page to be overseers of this my last will  
 and Testament In witness whereof I have subscribed  
 my hand in the presence of these mynisters my mynde  
 and full sense being good and lawfull And my wife shall  
 or shall have after my decease the use of the bequeathed  
 and not given shall after her decease be equally divided  
 betwix my sayd children Elizabeth to have Alexander  
 Connor Elizabeth; and Margaret Connor of the
