 Blaker and Thomas Blaker, for the bringing of them
 uppe to be payed at the age of twenty yeares, vs and
 of the paye thereof I should dye early to be payed
 to of for, Item I make myne Executors of Trust, for
 the Discharge of my goods towards the bringing uppe of my
 fore sayed Children John Gratwicke Edmund Blaker and
 John Wyllinge I doe appoynt these myne Executors of
 Trust to make sale of my goods towards the bringing uppe
 of my Children, And I doe make myne Overseers
 of this my last will and Testament my good frendes
 William West and Thomas Ashford, And yf they have
 any Travell about any cause herein contayned or any
 Busynesse I will they shalbe payed for their Charges
 and paynts, And so affirm that this ys my last will and
 Testament, I have subscribed with my hande and soules
